CHEECH MARIN PRESENTS CHICANO ART EXHIBITIONS AT THE MUZEEO JANUARY 26 THROUGH APRIL 27, 2008

WHO/WHAT: **About The Exhibits:**

- **The Chicano Collection/La Colección Chicana:** Digital reproductions (gicleés) of paintings by prominent Chicano artists depicting urban life and the Chicano experience between 1969 and 2001 will be on view at the MUZEEO (241 S. Anaheim Blvd., Anaheim, California). The prints are drawn primarily from actor and art collector Cheech Marin's collection and include works by 26 artists, including Carlos Almaraz, Frank Romero, Patssi Valdez, George Yepes, José Lozano, and Margaret García. The exhibition includes original linocut-print artist portraits by Artemio Rodríguez and a documentary film shown in the gallery.
- **Papel Chicano:** Works on Paper from the Collection of Cheech Marin: Bold and intense imagery rich in color has long been a trademark of art expressing the Chicano experience. Premiering for the first time in California, this exhibition includes original works on paper—primarily pastels, but also drawings, mixed media, oil, acrylic and gouaches. The 19 featured artists include Roberto Gutiérrez, Wayne Alaniz Healy, Leo Limón, Jesús "Chuy c/s" Rangel, Eloy Torrez, John Valadez, and Vincent Valdez.

About The MUZEEO:

The MUZEEO incorporates over 20,000 square feet for exhibition, meeting, education and collection storage incorporating:

- The Historic 1908 Carnegie Library, now the MUZEEO Program Building, has been newly refurbished and will display a regional history exhibition, along with hosting elements of the themed exhibition and a range of complimentary classes and activities.
- The New Exhibition Building adjacent to the Program Building – 5,000 square feet of main gallery with the capability of hosting small, medium and large exhibits. It will also feature a small theater ideal for small workshops and multimedia presentations, retail store, humidity controlled archive storage and a community reading room.
- Outside Program Plazas – Entry Plaza, Events Plaza, Program Courtyard.
